

Park Volunteer Programs

The City of Kenai Parks and Recreation Department has several opportunities for volunteer work. If you love spending your time outdoors, we may have the job for you! Below is a list of various opportunities through the Parks Division. For more opportunities, see beautification volunteer programs.

Adopt-a-Park:

Walk through your “adopted” park and pick up litter, report health and safety concerns and perform approved maintenance tasks.



Adopt-a-Trail:

Visit your trail once a week during the summer and keep it clean. Other tasks may include approved trail maintenance work such as tree removal, pruning, painting, and trail restoration work.

Adopt-a-Bench:

Purchase a bench with engraving to have placed in a pre-approved location of your choice. Great as a memorial bench inside a park, near a city facility, or along side a trail. Cost is approximately \$450.
